Your 3-Page Submission Should Include:

Page 1: Your Idea

- Catchy Project Name
- What your team wants to do and why
- Where it will take place
- What makes it exciting, different, or meaningful

Page 2: People & Plan

- Who is involved? (e.g. you, classmates, local designers, school clubs)
- What are the main steps or activities?
- How will you get others excited and involved?
- What materials or support will you need?

Page 3: Environmental Impact & Youth Leadership

- How does your idea help reduce waste or promote reuse?
- What will be the positive impact on your community or the planet?
- How will youth lead, design, and share the results?

Optional (Bonus!)

- Draw or upload a sketch or mini-poster
- Add a slogan, campaign hashtag, or social media idea
- Include a story or photo of a real upcycled item or "closet rescue"
